# 1978 No. 1050

## Rent (Northern Ireland) Order 1978

### PART XI

#### MISCELLANEOUS AND GENERAL

##### Application to Crown property

**75.**—(1) <sup>F1</sup> . . . this Order shall apply in relation to premises in which there subsists, or at any material time subsisted, a Crown estate as it applies in relation to premises in which no such estate subsists or ever subsisted.

(2) In this Article “Crown estate” means an estate—

- (a) which belongs to the Crown in right of Her Majesty's Government in the United Kingdom or in Northern Ireland; or
- (b) which is held in trust for Her Majesty for the purposes of a government department.
