SALE OF TOBACCO, ETC. TO PERSONS APPARENTLY UNDER [^{F1}18]

Prohibition on sale of tobacco, etc. to persons apparently under [^{F1}18]

3.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), a person who sells to a person^{F2}... under the age of [^{F3}18] any tobacco or cigarette papers, whether for his own use or not, shall be guilty of an offence.

 $[^{F2}(1A)$ It shall be a defence for a person charged with and offence under paragraph (1) to prove that he took all reasonable precautions and exercised all due diligence to avoid the commission of the offence.]

(3) A person guilty of an offence under paragraph (1) shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding $[{}^{F2}[{}^{F4}$ level 5] on the standard scale].
