**The Appropriation (No. 3)
(Northern Ireland) Order 1980**

Laid before Parliament in draft

Made 17th December 1980

Coming into Operation 17th December 1980

At the Court Buckingham Palace, the 17th day of December 1980

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Whereas a draft of this Order has been approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament:

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred by paragraph 1 of Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974 (a) and of all other powers enabling Her in that behalf, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

Title and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Appropriation (No.3) (Northern Ireland) Order 1980 and shall come into operation forthwith.

Interpretation

2. The Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954 (b) shall apply to Article 1 and the following provisions of this Order as it applies to a Measure of the Northern Ireland Assembly.

Issue of sum out of the Consolidated Fund for year ending on 31st March 1981

3. The Department of Finance may issue out of the Consolidated Fund and apply towards making good the supply granted to Her Majesty for the service of the year ending on 31st March 1981 the sum of one hundred and six million, seven hundred and fifty-five thousand pounds.

Power for Department of Finance to borrow

4.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), the Department of Finance may borrow on the credit of the aforesaid sum, any sum or sums not exceeding in the whole fifty-three million, three hundred and seventy-seven thousand pounds.

(2) Any money so borrowed shall be repaid, with any interest due thereon, out of the Consolidated Fund at any date not later than 31st March 1981.

Appropriation of grants

5.—(1) The sum granted by Article 3 out of the Consolidated Fund is appropriated for the several services and purposes expressed in Schedule 1.

(2) In addition to the sum granted by Article 3 out of the Consolidated Fund, the sums specified in the third column of Schedule 1 may be applied as appropriations in aid of the grants for the services in connection with which those sums are specified.

(3) The sums already authorised to be appropriated in aid for the year ending on 31st March 1981 shall be decreased by the sums specified in the fourth column of Schedule 1 for the services in connection with which those sums are specified.

Repeal of spent enactments

6. The enactments mentioned in Schedule 2 are hereby repealed to the extent specified in the third column of that Schedule.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order authorises the issue of a further sum out of the Consolidated Fund of Northern Ireland for the service of the year ending on 31st March 1981 and appropriates that sum for specified services in Northern Ireland. It also authorises the application of certain further sums as appropriations in aid and reduces seven sums already authorised to be applied as appropriations in aid. In addition, the Order repeals certain spent enactments.
