The Appropriation (No. 2)
(Northern Ireland) Order 1981

Laid before Parliament in draft

Made 31st July 1981

Coming into Operation 31st July 1981

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 31st day of July 1981

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Whereas a draft of this Order has been approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament:

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred by paragraph 1 of Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974 **(a)** and of all other powers enabling Her in that behalf, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

Title and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Appropriation (No. 2) (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and shall come into operation forthwith.

Interpretation

2. The Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954 **(b)** shall apply to Article 1 and the following provisions of this Order as it applies to a Measure of the Northern Ireland Assembly.

Issue of sums out of the Consolidated Fund for years ending on 31st March 1980 and 1982

3.—(1) The Department of Finance may issue out of the Consolidated Fund and apply towards making good the supply granted to Her Majesty for the service of the year ended on 31st March 1980, the sum of five hundred and fifty-nine thousand, nine hundred and sixty-one pounds.

(2) The Department of Finance may issue out of the Consolidated Fund and apply towards making good the supply granted to Her Majesty for the

service of the year ending on 31st March 1982 the sum of one thousand three hundred and sixty-seven million, one hundred and fifty thousand, eight hundred pounds.

Power for Department of Finance to borrow

4.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), the Department of Finance may borrow on the credit of the aforesaid sums, any sum or sums not exceeding in the whole six hundred and eighty-four million pounds.

(2) Any money so borrowed shall be repaid, with any interest due thereon, out of the Consolidated Fund at any date not later than 31st March 1982.

Appropriation of grants

5.—(1) The sums granted by Article 3 out of the Consolidated Fund are appropriated for the several services and purposes specified in the Schedule.

(2) The sums already authorised to be appropriated in aid for the year ended on 31st March 1980 shall be increased by the sums specified in column 3 of Part I of the Schedule for the service in connection with which those sums are specified.

(3) In addition to the sums granted by Article 3 out of the Consolidated Fund, there may be applied as appropriations in aid of the grants for the several services and purposes specified in Part II of the Schedule the sums respectively specified in column 3 of that Part.
