(Northern Ireland) Order 1983**

*Made* 27th July 1983

*Coming into Operation* 27th July 1983

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 27th day of July 1983

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Whereas a draft of this Order has been approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament:

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred by paragraph 1 of Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974 and of all other powers enabling Her in that behalf, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

*Title and commencement*

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Appropriation (No. 2) (Northern Ireland) Order 1983 and shall come into operation forthwith.

*Interpretation*

**2.** The Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954 shall apply to Article 1 and the following provisions of this Order as it applies to a Measure of the Northern Ireland Assembly.

*Issue of sum out of the Consolidated Fund for year ending 31st March 1984*

**3.** The Department of Finance and Personnel may issue out of the Consolidated Fund and apply towards making good the supply granted to Her Majesty for the service of the year ending on 31st March 1984 the sum of one thousand four hundred and eighty-three million, forty-three thousand, eight hundred pounds.
