**The Appropriation (No. 3)
(Northern Ireland) Order 1983**

Laid before Parliament in draft

Made 21st December 1983

Coming into Operation 21st December 1983

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 21st day of December 1983

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Whereas a draft of this Order has been approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament:

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred by paragraph 1 of Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974 and of all other powers enabling Her in that behalf, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

Title and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Appropriation (No. 3) (Northern Ireland) Order 1983 and shall come into operation forthwith.

Interpretation

2. The Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954 shall apply to Article 1 and the following provisions of this Order as it applies to a Measure of the Northern Ireland Assembly.

Issue of sum out of the Consolidated Fund for year ending on 31st March 1984

3. The Department of Finance and Personnel may issue out of the Consolidated Fund and apply towards making good the supply granted to Her Majesty for the service of the year ending on 31st March 1984 the sum of one hundred and seven million, one hundred and twenty-two thousand pounds.

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Power for Department of Finance and Personnel to borrow

4.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), the Department of Finance and Personnel may borrow on the credit of the aforesaid sum, any sum or sums not exceeding in the whole fifty-four million pounds.

(2) Any money so borrowed shall be repaid, with any interest due thereon, out of the Consolidated Fund at any date not later than 31st March 1984.

Appropriation of grants

5.—(1) The sum granted by Article 3 out of the Consolidated Fund is appropriated for the several services and purposes expressed in Schedule 1.

(2) In addition to the sum granted by Article 3 out of the Consolidated Fund, the sum specified in the third column of Schedule 1 may be applied as an appropriation in aid of the grant for the service in connection with which that sum is specified.

(3) The sums already authorised to be appropriated in aid for the year ending on 31st March 1984 shall be decreased by the sums specified in the fourth column of Schedule 1 for the services in connection with which those sums are specified.

Repeal of spent enactments

6. The enactments mentioned in Schedule 2 are hereby repealed to the extent specified in the third column of that Schedule.
