THE GENERAL CONSUMER COUNCIL FOR NORTHERN IRELAND

Incorporation and status

- 1.—(1) The Council shall be a body corporate with perpetual succession to which, subject to the provisions of this Schedule, section 19 of the Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954 shall apply.
- (2) The Council shall not be regarded as the servant or agent of the Crown or as enjoying any status, privilege or immunity of the Crown and the Council's property shall not be regarded as property of, or property held on behalf of, the Crown.
