Gifts

Presumption as to effect of gifts to spouses[^{F1} or civil partners]

23. Except where a contrary intention is shown, it is to be presumed that if, by his will, a testator makes a gift of property to his spouse[^{F1} or civil partner] in terms which in themselves would give an absolute interest to the spouse[^{F1} or civil partner], but by the same will purports to give his issue an interest in the same property, the gift to the spouse[^{F1} or civil partner] is absolute notwithstanding the purported gift to the issue.
