Execution of will

Witnessing by creditor

9. Where a will charges any property with a debt, any creditor whose debt is so charged, or the spouse^{F1} or civil partner] of any such creditor, is not incompetent, on account only of the charge,—

- (a) to act as a witness to the will; or
- (b) as a witness to prove—
 - (i) the execution of the will; or
 - (ii) the validity or invalidity of the will.
