The Statutory Sick Pay (Northern Ireland) Order 1994

Restriction of employers' right of recovery

3.—(1) In section 154(1)(a) of the Social Security Contributions and Benefits (Northern Ireland) Act 1992^{F1} (recovery by employers of amounts paid by way of statutory sick pay), sub-paragraph (ii) (recovery of 80 per cent. of payments not qualifying for small employers' relief) shall be omitted.

(2) In consequence the following are repealed—

(a) that sub-paragraph and the word “and” preceding it, and

(b) section 77(2) of the Social Security Administration (Northern Ireland) Act 1992^{F2};
