**The Wildlife (Amendment) (Northern Ireland) Order 1995**

**Power to issue general licences to kill wild birds**

3. In Article 18 of the 1985 Order (power to grant licences)—
- (a) for paragraph (6) there shall be substituted the following paragraphs—
    - “(6) A licence under this Article which authorises any person to kill wild birds—
      - (a) shall specify—
        - (i) the species of wild birds which may be killed;
        - (ii) the area within which, and the methods by which such wild birds may be killed; and
      - (b) subject to paragraph (5)(d), shall be valid for the period, not exceeding two years, stated in the licence.
    - (6A) A licence under this Article which authorises any person to kill wild animals—
      - (a) shall specify—
        - (i) the species of wild animals which may be killed and the person who is authorised to kill them;
        - (ii) the area within which, and the methods by which such wild animals may be killed; and
      - (b) subject to paragraph (5)(d), shall be valid for the period, not exceeding two years, stated in the licence.”; and
  - (b) in paragraph (5) for “paragraph (6)” there shall be substituted “paragraphs (6) and (6A)”.
