The Explosives (Amendment) (Northern Ireland) Order 1996

Control of fireworks

- **3.**—(1) Explosives regulations may, in relation to fireworks, make any such provision as may be made by such regulations in relation to any other description of explosives; and, accordingly, in section 3(1) of the Explosives Act (Northern Ireland) 1970 the words "or the sale or use of fireworks" are hereby repealed.
 - (2) Without prejudice to the generality of paragraph (1), Explosives regulations may—
 - (a) provide for there to be different categories of fireworks; and
 - (b) make different provisions for different categories of fireworks.
- (3) In section 1 of the Explosives Act (Northern Ireland) 1970 after subsection (4) there shall be inserted the following subsection—
 - "(4A) Subsections (1) and (2) shall not apply to fireworks of such categories as may be prescribed by Explosives regulations.".
- (4) In this Article "Explosives regulations" has the meaning assigned to it by section 3(1) of the Explosives Act (Northern Ireland) 1970.
