APPLICATIONS FOR EXTENSION LICENCES

2. A person who intends to make an application for the grant of a licence [^{F1}or authorisation] shall, not less than 2 weeks before the time when he wishes the application to be considered, serve notice of the application upon the clerk of petty sessions and at the same time serve a copy of the notice upon—

- (a) the sub-divisional commander of the police sub-division in which the premises to which the application relates are situated; and
- (b) the district council for the district in which the premises are situated.
