DURATION OF BANKRUPTCY: TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS

Introduction

1. his Schedule applies to an individual who immediately before commencement—
 - (a) has been adjudged bankrupt, and
 - (b) has not been discharged from the bankruptcy.
