# The Sexual Offences (Northern Ireland) Order 2008

### PART 2

## NON-CONSENSUAL SEXUAL OFFENCES

#### Assault

#### Sexual assault

- 7.—(1) A person (A) commits an offence if—
  - (a) he intentionally touches another person (B),
  - (b) the touching is sexual,
  - (c) B does not consent to the touching, and
  - (d) A does not reasonably believe that B consents.
- (2) Whether a belief is reasonable is to be determined having regard to all the circumstances, including any steps A has taken to ascertain whether B consents.
  - (3) Articles 9 and 10 apply to an offence under this Article.
  - (4) A person guilty of an offence under this Article is liable—
    - (a) on summary conviction, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 6 months or a fine not exceeding the statutory maximum or both;
    - (b) on conviction on indictment, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 10 years.
