**TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT****Calculation of Redundancy Payments Order (Northern Ireland) 1974***Made* . . . . . 5th August 1974*Coming into operation* . . . . . 28th August 1974*To be laid before Parliament under paragraph 3(3) of Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974*

The Department of Manpower Services in exercise of the powers conferred on it by paragraph 5 of Schedule 3 to the Contracts of Employment and Redundancy Payments Act (Northern Ireland) 1965(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:

*Citation and commencement*

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Calculation of Redundancy Payments Order (Northern Ireland) 1974 and shall come into operation on 28th August 1974.

*Interpretation*

2. In this Order—

“the Act” means the Contracts of Employment and Redundancy Payments Act (Northern Ireland) 1965.

*The amount of a week's pay*

3. Sub-paragraph (3) of paragraph 5 of Schedule 3 to the Act shall have effect as if, in relation to any redundancy payment which any employer becomes liable to pay on or after the coming into operation of this Order, for the sum of £40, there were substituted the sum of £80.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)*

This Order increases from £40 to £80 the maximum amount which can be taken into account in respect of weekly pay for the purposes of calculating a redundancy payment under Schedule 3 to the Contracts of Employment and Redundancy Payments Act (Northern Ireland) 1965.
