## Rainbow Trout Waters

BYE-LAWS, DATED 24TH JANUARY 1974, MADE BY THE FISHERIES CONSERVANCY BOARD FOR NORTHERN IRELAND WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE UNDER SECTION 26 OF THE FISHERIES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1966.

The Fisheries Conservancy Board for Northern Ireland in exercise of its powers under section 26 of the Fisheries Act (Northern Ireland) 1966(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, with the approval of the Department of Agriculture, hereby makes the following Bye-laws:—

1. These Bye-laws may be cited as the Rainbow Trout Waters Bye-laws (Northern Ireland) 1974.

2. These Bye-laws come into effect on 18th February 1974.

3. The under-named waters are hereby designated as Rainbow Trout Waters and there shall be no close season for angling for rainbow trout thereon:—

4. The Rainbow Trout Waters Bye-laws (Northern Ireland) 1971(b) are hereby revoked.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Bye-laws, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)*

These Bye-laws designate a number of waters as rainbow trout waters and provide that there shall be no close season for angling for rainbow trout in those waters.
