## COUNTY COURTS

## Dungannon Division—Place of Sittings

ORDER, DATED 24TH DECEMBER 1974, MADE BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE UNDER SECTION 2(2) OF THE COUNTY COURTS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1959.

In pursuance of section 2(2) of the County Courts Act (Northern Ireland) 1959(a), I hereby make the following Order:—

*Citation and commencement*

1. This Order may be cited as the County Court Place of Sittings (Dungannon Division) (No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1974 and shall come into operation on the 1st January 1975.

*Place of sitting of County Court for the Dungannon Division of County Tyrone*

2.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), the sittings of the County Court for the division of Dungannon in the year 1975 shall be held in the courthouse at Cookstown at the times appointed for the holding of the said court.

(2) The sittings in the year 1975 for the trial by jury of criminal cases shall be held in the courthouse at Omagh at the time so appointed.

*Revocation*

3. The County Court Place of Sittings (Dungannon Division) Order (Northern Ireland) 1974(b) is hereby revoked.
