Poultry Testing (Amendment) Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1975

Made 23rd April 1975

Coming into operation 13th June 1975

*To be laid before Parliament under paragraph 3(3) of
Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974*

The Department of Agriculture, after consultation as required by section 12(1) of the Poultry Improvement Act (Northern Ireland) 1968(a) and with the approval of the Department of Finance, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 8 of the said Act and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Scheme:

Citation and commencement

1.—(1) This Scheme may be cited as the Poultry Testing (Amendment) Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1975.

(2) This Scheme shall come into operation on 13th June 1975.

Amendment of the Poultry Testing Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1970

2. In paragraph (1)(a) and (b) of Article 6 of the Poultry Testing Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1970(b) for “£150” there shall be substituted “£300”.
