TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING**Planning (Claims for Compensation) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1975***Made* 30th April 1975*Coming into operation* 1st June 1975

The Department of Housing, Local Government and Planning(a), in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Articles 77 and 106 of the Planning (Northern Ireland) Order 1972(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Planning (Claims for Compensation) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1975 and shall come into operation on 1st June 1975.

Claims for compensation

2. A claim for compensation made to the Department of Housing, Local Government and Planning under Article 77 of the Planning (Northern Ireland) Order 1972 shall be made in writing within 6 months from the date on which the order, in respect of which the claim is made, comes into force or such longer period as the said Department may allow in any particular case.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

The purpose of these regulations is to prescribe the time within which and the manner in which claims for compensation shall be made by certain persons affected by the making of orders extinguishing the right to use vehicles on roads.
