Coming into operation 1st August 1975

The Registrar, with the consent of the Department(a) of Commerce, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 123(1) of the Building Societies Act (Northern Ireland) 1967(b), hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Building Societies (Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1975 and shall come into operation on 1st August 1975.

Revocation

2. The Building Societies (Amendment of Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1971(c) are hereby revoked.

Amendment of fees

3. The Building Societies (Forms and Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1968(d) shall be amended by substituting for Schedule 2 thereto the following Schedule:
