Londonderry Area (Sea Boundary) Order (Northern Ireland) 1975

Made 22nd May 1975

Coming into operation 1st June 1975

The Department of Agriculture(a) in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 16 of the Fisheries Act (Northern Ireland) 1966 (Reprint to 1969)(b) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Londonderry Area (Sea Boundary) Order (Northern Ireland) 1975 and shall come into operation on 1st June 1975.

2. The boundary between so much of such part of the fishery limits of the British Islands as is mentioned in Section 4(2) of the Fishery Limits Act 1964(c) as is within, and so much thereof as is without, the Londonderry Area shall be a line running due north from the point described in the Fishery Districts (Northern Ireland) Order 1925(d) as the sea point of the townland boundary between the townlands of Downhill and Drumagully in the County of Londonderry to latitude 55° 13' N thence in a direction 25° E of N to latitude 55° 16' N thence in a direction 10° E of N to where this line cuts the line which marks the seaward boundary of the fishery limits of the British Islands.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order defines the boundary at sea between the respective fishery conservancy areas which are within the jurisdiction of the Foyle Fisheries Commission and the Fisheries Conservancy Board for Northern Ireland.
