Mycoplasma gallisepticum Control (Revocation) Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1975

3rd June 1975 Made 23rd July 1975 Coming into operation

To be laid before Parliament under paragraph 3(3) of Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974

The Department(a) of Agriculture, after consultation as required by section 12(1) of the Poultry Improvement Act (Northern Ireland) 1968(b) and in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 1 of the said Act and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Scheme:

Citation and commencement

- 1.—(1) This Scheme may be cited as the Mycoplasma gallisepticum Control (Revocation) Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1975.
 - (2) The Scheme shall come into operation on 23rd July 1975.

Revocation

2. The Mycoplasma gallisepticum Control Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1971(c) is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Scheme but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Scheme revokes entirely the Mycoplasma gallisepticum Control Scheme under which the Department of Agriculture was empowered to provide a voluntary fee paying Scheme to test for the presence or absence of Mycoplasma gallisepticum (PPLO) in poultry breeding stock.
