## SOCIAL SECURITY

**The Social Security Pensions (1975 Order) (Commencement No. 1) Order  
(Northern Ireland) 1975***Made* . . . . . 26th September 1975*Coming into operation* . . . . . 26th September 1975

WHEREAS by Article 1(3) of the Social Security Pensions (Northern Ireland) Order 1975(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Order"), it is provided that the Order shall come into force on such day or days as the Secretary of State may by order appoint:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State hereby makes the following order:

1.—(1) In relation only to persons born on or after 2nd January 1950 but before 2nd January 1961, the day appointed for the coming into force of Article 24 of the Order, of Article 74(1) of the Order (so far as it relates to paragraphs 29 and 31 to 33 of Schedule 5 to the Order) and of paragraphs 29 and 31 to 33 of the said Schedule 5, shall be—

- (a) for the purposes of the making of claims for and the determination of claims and questions relating to mobility allowance, 6th October 1975; and
- (b) for all other purposes, 1st January 1976.

(2) The day appointed for the coming into force—

- (a) of Article 74(1) (so far as it relates to the paragraphs of Schedule 5 specified in the Schedule to this order); and
- (b) of those further provisions of the Order specified in the latter Schedule,

shall be 1st October 1975.

2. This order may be cited as the Social Security Pensions (1975 Order) (Commencement No. 1) Order (Northern Ireland) 1975.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)*

This order brings into force provisions of the Social Security Pensions (Northern Ireland) Order 1975 required for the introduction of mobility allowance; provision whereby a person with simultaneous entitlement to more than one pension under the Social Security (Northern Ireland) Act 1975 may choose which pension to receive; and a number of provisions relating to financial, technical or general matters.
