ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

Restriction of Traffic (Saint Francis Terrace) Order (Northern Ireland) 1975

Made 3rd October 1975

Coming into operation 1st December 1975

WHEREAS the Department of the Environment for Northern Ireland is satisfied that the road described in Article 2 cannot be used by vehicles without endangering the safety of persons using the road:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Department of the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred by section 20 of the Road Traffic Act (Northern Ireland) 1970(a) and now vested in it(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Restriction of Traffic (Saint Francis Terrace) Order (Northern Ireland) 1975 and shall come into operation on 1st December 1975.

2. Vehicles are prohibited from using that part of Saint Francis Terrace, Londonderry, extending for a distance of ten metres from its junction with Buncrana Road.
