**ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES****Restriction of Traffic (Park Lane) Order (Northern Ireland) 1975***Made . . . . . 21st October 1975**Coming into operation . . . . . 22nd December 1975*

WHEREAS the Department of the Environment for Northern Ireland is satisfied that the road described in Article 2(1) is unsuitable for unrestricted use by vehicles:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Department of the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred by section 20 of the Road Traffic Act (Northern Ireland) 1970(a) and now vested in it(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Restriction of Traffic (Park Lane) Order (Northern Ireland) 1975 and shall come into operation on 22nd December 1975.

2.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2) vehicles are prohibited from using Park Lane, Hillsborough, from its junction with the Square, to its junction with Park Street.

(2) Paragraph (1) shall not apply to the use of the said road by vehicles being used by the owners or occupiers of premises abutting on or convenient to the said road or for the delivery to or collection from such premises of goods of any kind, or in connection with public utility or emergency services.
