The Child Benefit (1975 Order) (Commencement No. 1) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1975

Made 3rd November 1975

Coming into operation 5th April 1976

The Department of Health and Social Services for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 18(2) of the Child Benefit (Northern Ireland) Order 1975(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Child Benefit (1975 Order) (Commencement No. 1) Order (Northern Ireland) 1975 and shall come into operation on 5th April 1976.

Date on which the interim period begins

2. The day specified by the Department under paragraph (2) of Article 18 of the Child Benefit (Northern Ireland) Order 1975 (which Article provides an interim benefit for unmarried or separated parents with children during the interim period) as the day on which the interim period begins is Monday 5th April 1976.

EXPLANATORY NOTE
