**The Social Security Pensions (1975 Order) (Commencement No. 2) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1975***Made* 25th November 1975*Coming into operation* 25th November 1975

WHEREAS by Article 1(3) of the Social Security Pensions (Northern Ireland) Order 1975(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Order"), it is provided that the Order shall come into force on such day or days as the Secretary of State may by order appoint:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State hereby makes the following order:

1. This order may be cited as the Social Security Pensions (1975 Order) (Commencement No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1975.

2.—(1) The day appointed for the coming into operation—

- (a) of the provisions specified in column (1) of Schedule 1 shall (subject to the provisions of paragraph (2)) be 28th November 1975;
- (b) of the provisions specified in column (1) of Schedule 2 shall be 6th April 1977;
- (c) of the provisions specified in column (1) of Schedule 3 shall be 6th April 1978; and
- (d) of the provisions specified in column (1) of Schedule 4 shall be 6th April 1979.

(2) Paragraph (1)(a) shall have effect—

- (a) in relation to the provisions of Articles 28, 32(1) to (3) and 34 to 43 of the Order, only for the purpose of the issue, cancellation, variation or surrender before, but with effect from dates not earlier than, 6th April 1978 of contracting-out certificates (including amended certificates) and for purposes connected with that purpose; and
- (b) in relation to the provisions of Articles 55 to 58 of the Order, only for the purpose of enabling steps to be taken before 6th April 1978 to secure that on and after that date occupational pension schemes conform with the equal access requirements and for purposes connected with that purpose;

and for all other purposes the date appointed for the coming into operation of the provisions specified in this paragraph shall be 6th April 1978.

(3) The day appointed for the coming into operation of Article 25 of the Order shall be 6th April 1976.

This order appoints the dates for the coming into force of all those provisions of the Social Security Pensions (Northern Ireland) Order 1975 which are not already in operation, except Article 24 (mobility allowance: this Article is already in operation for certain purposes only), Article 32(5) (amendment of the Contracts of Employment and Redundancy Payments Act (Northern Ireland) 1965 (1965 c. 19)), Articles 44 to 48 (state scheme premiums), Article 59 (preservation of benefit), Article 65 (rule against perpetuities) and certain provisions, related to those Articles, in Schedules 5 and 6.
