Warble Fly (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1975

Made 28th November 1975

Coming into operation 1st January 1976

The Department(a) of Agriculture, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Sections 18 and 53 of the Diseases of Animals Act (Northern Ireland) 1958(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order :

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Warble Fly (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1975 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1976.

Amendment and revocation

2. Article 5 of the Warble Fly Order (Northern Ireland) 1969(c) as substituted by Article 3 of the Warble Fly (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1971(d) and amended by Article 2 of the Warble Fly (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1972(e) shall be further amended as follows :

- (i) paragraph (1) shall be revoked;
- (ii) in paragraph (3) the word "further" shall be deleted.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order amends the Warble Fly Order (Northern Ireland) 1969 by removing the requirement that all bovine animals (apart from those under 12 months) imported from the Republic of Ireland should be accompanied by a valid certificate of treatment for warble infestation.

The restrictions relating to the import of animals showing visible evidence of infestation are, however, still in operation.
