HEALTH AND PERSONAL SOCIAL SERVICES**Charges for Drugs and Appliances***Made* 23rd December 1975*Coming into operation* 1st January 1976

The Department of Health and Social Services(a) in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 98, 106 and 107, of, and Schedule 15 to, the Health and Personal Social Services (Northern Ireland) Order 1972(b) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf and with the approval of the Department of Finance(a) hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Health and Personal Social Services (Charges for Drugs and Appliances) (Amendment No. 3) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1975 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1976.

Amendment of regulations

2. The Health and Personal Social Services (Charges for Drugs and Appliances) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1973(c) shall be amended as follows:

For regulation 9(4) there shall be substituted:

“(4) This regulation shall not apply to the supply of

- (a) children’s glasses where the standard type of children’s frames as described in the Statement of Fees and Charges is used;
- (b) glasses to children for which frames other than the standard type of children’s frame as described in the Statement of Fees and Charges are used solely for clinical reasons;
- (c) contact lenses to a person to whom children’s glasses may be supplied and for whom such lenses are clinically necessary”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These regulations amend the Health and Personal Social Services (Charges for Drugs and Appliances) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1973 by providing that children supplied with contact lenses will be exempt from charges if contact lenses are clinically necessary.
