The Department of Health and Social Services(a) in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 98, 106 and 107 of, and paragraph 1(b) of Schedule 15 to, the Health and Personal Social Services (Northern Ireland) Order 1972(b) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf and in conjunction with the Department of Finance(a) hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Health and Personal Social Services (Remission of Charges) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1975 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1976.

Amendment

2. In regulation 6(1)(b)(i) of the Health and Personal Social Services (Remission of Charges) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1974(c) as amended(d) for the amount "£1.50" there shall be substituted the amount "£2.50".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These regulations further amend the Health and Personal Social Services (Remission of Charges) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1974 by increasing the amount of a claimant's deemed requirements for the purposes of calculating his entitlement to a remission.
