**ROYAL ULSTER CONSTABULARY RESERVE****Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve (Appointment and Conditions of Service) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1975***Made* . . . . . 20th March 1975*Coming into operation* . . . . . 29th April 1975*To be laid before Parliament*

The Secretary of State(a), in pursuance of section 26 of the Police Act (Northern Ireland) 1970(b), read with section 18 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1962(c), and after consulting, in accordance with section 34(2) of the said Act of 1970, the Police Authority for Northern Ireland and the Police Association for Northern Ireland hereby, with the concurrence of the Minister for the Civil Service(d), makes the following regulations:

*Citation, operation and effective date*

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve (Appointment and Conditions of Service) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1975.

(2) These regulations shall come into operation on 29th April 1975 and shall have effect as from 1st December 1974.

*Amendment of regulation 13 of 1973 Regulations*

2. In regulation 13(1) of the Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve (Appointment and Conditions of Service) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1973(e) for the words "Reserve Constable at" to the end there shall be substituted the words "Reserve Constable at the rate of £24 per annum".

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)*

These regulations amend the Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve (Appointment and Conditions of Service) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1973 by prescribing the annual rate of remuneration of a reserve constable (including a probationary reserve constable) as £24.

These regulations have effect from 1st December 1974; retrospection is authorised by section 18 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1962.
