## EDUCATION

**Voluntary Grammar Schools Building Grants (Amendment) Regulations  
(Northern Ireland) 1975**

*Made* . . . . . 3rd April 1975

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 1st June 1975

The Department of Education(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Department") in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 106 and 125 of the Education and Libraries (Northern Ireland) Order 1972(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf and with the approval of the Department of Finance(c) hereby makes the following regulations:

*Citation and commencement*

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Voluntary Grammar Schools Building Grant (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1975.

(2) These regulations shall come into operation on 1st June 1975.

*Amendment of regulations*

2. The Voluntary Grammar Schools Building Grant Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1973(d) shall be amended as follows:

For paragraph (3) of regulation 7 there shall be substituted the following paragraph:

“(3) The Department may pay grants by instalments, the first of which shall not be paid until at least five per cent of the estimated cost of the work has been met by the applicants and the final instalment of grant shall not be paid until the work has been completed to the satisfaction of the Department and any defects liability period prescribed in the contract documents has expired.”.
