**The Social Security (Contributions) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations
(Northern Ireland) 1976***Made* 29th March 1976*Coming into operation* 6th April 1976

The Department of Health and Social Services for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 8(1) of, and paragraph 6(1)(d) of Schedule 1 to, the Social Security (Northern Ireland) Act 1975(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation, interpretation and commencement

1. These regulations, which may be cited as the Social Security (Contributions) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1976, shall be read as one with the Social Security (Contributions) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1975(b), as amended(c) (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations") and shall come into operation on 6th April 1976.

Amendment of regulations 24(1) and 38(1) and (3) of the principal regulations

2. In regulations 24(1) (Class 3 contributions) and 38(1) and (3) (application for allocation of national insurance number) of the principal regulations for "school-leaving age" wherever that expression occurs there shall be substituted "the age of 16".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These regulations are made as a consequence of amendments to the Social Security (Northern Ireland) Act 1975 made by the Social Security and Family Allowances (Northern Ireland) Order 1976 and accordingly substitute "the age of 16" for references in the Social Security (Contributions) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1975 to "school-leaving age".
