## FISHERIES

**Foyle Area (Licensing of Fishing Engines)  
(Amendment) Regulations 1976**

*Made* . . . . . 13th April 1976

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 1st May 1976

The Foyle Fisheries Commission in exercise of its powers under Section 13 of the Foyle Fisheries Act 1952(a) and Section 13 of the Foyle Fisheries Act (Northern Ireland) 1952(b), with the approval of the Minister for Agriculture and Fisheries in the Republic of Ireland and the Department(c) of Agriculture for Northern Ireland hereby makes the following regulations:—

1. These regulations shall be cited as the Foyle Area (Licensing of Fishing Engines) (Amendment) Regulations 1976 and shall come into operation on 1st May 1976.

2. There shall be substituted for the First Schedule to the Foyle Area (Licensing of Fishing Engines) Regulations 1960(d) the following Schedule:

Drift Net used wholly to seaward of Lough Foyle (the seaward limit of which for the purpose of these regulations shall be deemed to be an imaginary straight line drawn between Greencastle Fort in the County of Donegal and the Martello Tower at Magilligan Point in the County of Londonderry)	34.00

Rod and line (available for whole season) . . . . .	3.00
Rod and line (available for seven days) . . . . .	1.00
Rod and line (available for whole season provided applicant can produce at the time of application a season salmon rod licence for the time being in force and issued by a Board of Conservators or the Fisheries Conservancy Board for Northern Ireland)	1.50*
