**PHARMACY AND POISONS****Pharmaceutical Society of Northern Ireland**

Made 18th May 1976

Coming into operation 1st August 1976

The Council of the Pharmaceutical Society of Northern Ireland in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 3 of the Pharmacy and Poisons Act (Northern Ireland) 1925(a) and of every other power enabling them in that behalf hereby makes the following regulations:—

*Citation and Interpretation*

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Pharmaceutical Society of Northern Ireland (General) (Amendment) Regulations 1976 and shall come into operation on 1st August 1976.

(2) In these regulations the “principal Regulations” means the Pharmaceutical Society of Northern Ireland (General) Regulations 1974(b).

*Amendment of Regulations*

2.—(1) For regulation 4 of the principal Regulations there shall be substituted the following regulation:

“4. The retention fee under section 8 of the Act of 1945 payable annually by a member of the Society in respect of the retention of his name on the Register shall be £20, provided that—

- (i) a member of the Society who was a life member on the 24th May 1945 shall not pay a retention fee;
- (ii) a member of the Society who resides outside Northern Ireland or who satisfies the Secretary that he has attained his 65th birthday shall pay a retention fee of £5”.

(2) The Schedule to the principal Regulations is hereby revoked.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)*

These Regulations increase from £12 to £20 the retention fee payable by a member of the Pharmaceutical Society of Northern Ireland in respect of the retention of his name on the Register. The Regulations also remove the provision whereby a member of the Society may pay a reduced retention fee if he indicated that he did not expect to be gainfully employed for more than 13 weeks during the year for which the fee was payable.
