**Employment in Agriculture (Amendment) Scheme
(Northern Ireland) 1976***Made* 15th July 1976*Coming into operation* 5th August 1976

The Department of Agriculture in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 1 of the Agriculture (Temporary Assistance) Act (Northern Ireland) 1954(a) as amended by the Agriculture (Temporary Assistance) (Amendment) Act (Northern Ireland) 1957(b) and now vested in it(c) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, and with the approval of the Department(d) of Finance, hereby makes the following Scheme:

Citation and commencement

1.—(1) This Scheme may be cited as the Employment in Agriculture (Amendment) Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1976.

(2) The Employment in Agriculture (Northern Ireland) Scheme 1972(e) (herein referred to as the Principal Scheme) and this Scheme may be cited together as the Employment in Agriculture (Northern Ireland) Schemes 1972-1976.

(3) This Scheme shall come into operation on 5th August 1976.

Amendment of Principal Scheme

2. In Article 5(3) of the Principal Scheme for “£11,000,000” there shall be substituted “£18,000,000”.
