**Students Awards (Amendment No. 2) Regulations
(Northern Ireland) 1976***Made* 23rd December 1976*Coming into operation* 23rd December 1976

The Department(a) of Education in exercise of the powers vested in it by Articles 39 and 125 of the Education and Libraries (Northern Ireland) Order 1972(b) and by section 18 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1962(c) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Students Awards (Amendment No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1976 and these regulations, the Students Awards (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1976(d) and the Students Awards Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1975(e) may be cited together as the Students Awards Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1975 to 1976.

(2) These regulations shall come into operation on 23rd December 1976 and shall be deemed to have effect from 1st September 1976.

Amendment

2. For sub-paragraph 3(b) of regulation 17 of the Students Awards Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1975 there shall be substituted:

“(b) in respect of a year in which there are no periods of full-time study no payments shall be made in pursuance of an award other than in a case where supervision or other fees are charged by the institution concerned when the amount of such fees shall be paid.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These regulations amend the Students Awards Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1975 by modifying the existing provisions relating to the value of awards for sandwich courses.

The authority for making these regulations retrospective is section 18 of the Administrative and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1962.
