LOCAL GOVERNMENT

Local Government (General Grant) Order (Northern Ireland) 1976

Made 13th February 1976

Coming into operation 1st April 1976

*To be laid before Parliament under paragraph 3(3) of
Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974.*

The Department of Housing, Local Government and Planning(a) in exercise of the powers conferred on it by paragraph 3(1) of Part 1 of Schedule 1 to the Local Government &c. (Northern Ireland) Order 1972(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Order.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Local Government (General Grant) Order (Northern Ireland) 1976 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1976.

General grant

2. For the purposes of paragraph 3(1) of Part 1 of Schedule 1 to the Local Government &c. (Northern Ireland) Order 1972 the districts specified for the year ending on 31st March 1977 shall be the districts listed below.
