**WAGES COUNCILS****Road Haulage Wages Regulation (Amendment) Order  
(Northern Ireland) 1976***Made* . . . . . 2nd January 1976*Coming into operation* . . . . . 20th January 1976

The Department of Manpower Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 10 of the Wages Councils Act (Northern Ireland) 1945(a) and now vested in it(b) hereby makes the following Order to give effect to wages regulation proposals received from the Road Haulage Wages Council (Northern Ireland):

*Citation*

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Haulage Wages Regulation (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1976.

*Commencement*

2. The wages regulation proposals set out in the Schedule shall come into operation on the specified date.

*Interpretation*

3. In this Order the expression "the specified date" means the 20th day of January 1976, provided that where, as respects any worker who is paid wages at intervals not exceeding seven days, that date does not correspond with the beginning of the period for which the wages are paid, the expression "the specified date" means as respects that worker, the beginning of the next such period following that date.

SCHEDULE

Statutory Minimum Remuneration

The Road Haulage Wages Regulation Order (Northern Ireland) 1974 shall have effect as if in the Schedule thereto—

1.—For the heading MALE WORKERS above paragraph 1 there was substituted the heading ALL WORKERS.

2.—For paragraph 1A and the notes 1 and 2 relating thereto there was substituted the following paragraph:—

Paragraph 1A

COST OF LIVING SUPPLEMENT

The Retail Price Index having exceeded the appropriate trigger points mentioned in the Pay Board Stage 3 Guidelines leaflet of June 1974, there shall be paid to full-time adult employees, with proportionate increases to juveniles, a Cost of Living Supplement of £1.60 per week.

3.—After Paragraph 1A there was inserted the following paragraph:—

Paragraph 1B

“ATTACK ON INFLATION” SUPPLEMENT

In addition to the remuneration paid under Paragraphs 1 and 1A there shall be paid a further supplement, entitled the “Attack on Inflation” Supplement, as follows:—

- (a) DRIVER (as defined in paragraph 8) of a vehicle (as defined in paragraph 8) .. .. .
- (b) ASSISTANT (as defined in paragraph 8) who is aged
  - 21 years and over .. .. .
  - 20 years and under 21 years .. .. .
  - 19 years and under 20 years .. .. .
  - 18 years and under 19 years .. .. .
  - 17 years and under 18 years .. .. .
  - under 17 years .. .. .

4.—For the heading ADDITIONAL PAYMENT FOR CERTAIN MALE WORKERS above paragraph 2 there was substituted the heading ADDITIONAL PAYMENT FOR CERTAIN WORKERS.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)*

This Order which comes into operation on 20th January 1976 amends the Road Haulage Wages Regulation Order (Northern Ireland) 1974 (Order N.I.R.H. (56)) by increasing the statutory minimum remuneration fixed by that Order.

New provisions in the Schedule are printed in italics.
