## SOCIAL SECURITY

**The Social Security Pensions (1975 Order) (Commencement No. 8)  
Order (Northern Ireland) 1977**

*Made* . . . . . 20th May 1977

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 25th May 1977

WHEREAS by Article 1(3) of the Social Security Pensions (Northern Ireland) Order 1975(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Order"), it is provided that the Order shall come into force on such day or days as the Secretary of State may by order appoint:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State hereby makes the following order:

1. In relation to persons born on or after 25th August 1923 but before 2nd April 1925, the day appointed for the coming into force of Article 24 of the Order, of Article 74(1) of the Order (so far as it relates to the paragraphs of Schedule 5 to the Order specified in this Article) and of paragraphs 29 and 31 to 33 of the said Schedule 5, shall be—

(a) for the purposes of the making of claims for, and the determination of claims and questions relating to, mobility allowance, 25th May 1977; and

(b) for all other purposes, 24th August 1977.

2. This order may be cited as the Social Security Pensions (1975 Order) (Commencement No. 8) Order (Northern Ireland) 1977 and shall come into operation on 25th May 1977.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)*

This order brings into force provisions of the Social Security Pensions (Northern Ireland) Order 1975, relating to mobility allowance which, in accordance with power expressly provided in that Order, are brought into force on the days appointed by this order only in relation to persons of specified age groups.
