In exercise of the powers conferred on me by article 1(1) of the Police (Northern Ireland) Order 1977(a) I hereby make the following order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Police (1977 Order) (Commencement No. 1) Order (Northern Ireland) 1977 and shall come into operation on 15th June 1977.

2. The day appointed for the coming into operation of the provisions of the Police (Northern Ireland) Order 1977 specified in the first column of the Schedule (which relate to the matters specified in the second column thereof) shall be 15th June 1977.
