ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

Off-Street Parking (Amendment) Bye-Laws (Northern Ireland) 1977

Made 28th January 1977

Coming into operation 21st February 1977

The Department of the Environment for Northern Ireland in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 89 of the Road Traffic Act (Northern Ireland) 1970(a) and now vested in it(b) hereby makes the following Bye-laws:—

Citation and commencement

1. These Bye-laws may be cited as the Off-Street Parking (Amendment) Bye-laws (Northern Ireland) 1977 and shall come into operation on 21st February 1977.

Bye-laws amended

2. The Off-Street Parking Bye-laws (Northern Ireland) 1976(c) shall be amended by the addition to Schedule 1, Part I, of the parking places included in the Schedule.
