(Commencement No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1977***Made* 15th November 1977*Coming into operation* 1st January 1978

The Department of Health and Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 1(3) of the Social Security (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Northern Ireland) Order 1977(a), paragraph 2(1) and (2) of Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974(b) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Social Security (Miscellaneous Provisions) (1977 Order) (Commencement No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1977 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1978.

Appointed day

2. The day appointed for the coming into force of Article 18(21) of the Social Security (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Northern Ireland) Order 1977 (amendment of section 19 of the 1966 Act) shall be 1st January 1978.

(This note is not part of the order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This order brings into operation Article 18(21) of the Social Security (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Northern Ireland) Order 1977 which amends section 19 of the Supplementary Benefits &c. Act (Northern Ireland) 1966 (c. 28) providing for an appeal on a point of law from a Supplementary Benefits Appeal Tribunal to the Court of Appeal.
