**Foyle Area (Licensing of Fishing Engines) (Amendment No. 2)
Regulations 1978**

Made 27th April 1978

Coming into operation 1st May 1978

The Foyle Fisheries Commission, in exercise of its powers under section 13 of the Foyle Fisheries Act 1952(a) and section 13 of the Foyle Fisheries Act (Northern Ireland) 1952(b) with the approval of the Minister for Fisheries in the Republic of Ireland and of the Department(c) of Agriculture for Northern Ireland, hereby makes the following regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Foyle Area (Licensing of Fishing Engines) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 1978, and shall come into operation on 1st May 1978.

2. The Foyle Area (Licensing of Fishing Engines) Regulations 1976(d) are hereby amended by the substitution of the following for Parts I and II of the Schedule:—

Draft Net used wholly or partly in the tidal waters of the River Foyle between the confluence of the Rivers Mourne and Finn and an imaginary straight line drawn across the River Foyle to join the points where the southernmost boundary of the County of Londonderry meets the river on each side	65.00
Draft Net used wholly in the waters of the Foyle Area elsewhere than in the tidal waters of the River Foyle between the confluence of the Rivers Mourne and Finn and an imaginary straight line drawn across the River Foyle to join the points where the southernmost boundary of the County of Londonderry meets the river on each side	50.00
Drift Net used wholly to seaward of Lough Foyle (the seaward limit of which for the purpose of these regulations shall be deemed to be an imaginary straight line drawn between Greencastle Fort in the County of Donegal and the Martello Tower at Magilligan Point in the County of Londonderry)	50.00
Drift Net used wholly in Lough Foyle, or partly in the said Lough Foyle and partly seaward of the seaward limit of Lough Foyle as aforesaid	60.00

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations replace the Foyle Area (Licensing of Fishing Engines) (Amendment) Regulations 1978, which increased the licence fees to be paid in respect of each type of net used in the Foyle Area. There is no practical difference between these Regulations and the Foyle Area (Licensing of Fishing Engines) (Amendment) Regulations 1978. The reason for making these Regulations is that the previous Regulations appeared to be invalid in Northern Ireland as they were not approved within 1 month of being made.
