## ANIMALS

**Johne's Disease (Compensation) Order (Northern Ireland) 1978**

Made . . . . . 20th July 1978

Coming into operation . . . . . 1st September 1978

The Department(a) of Agriculture, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 10 and 53 of the Diseases of Animals Act (Northern Ireland) 1958(b) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

*Citation and commencement*

1. This Order may be cited as the Johne's Disease (Compensation) Order (Northern Ireland) 1978 and shall come into operation on 1st September 1978.

*Amendment of Part II of the Second Schedule*

2. Part II of the Second Schedule to the Act shall be amended as follows:—

(1) in paragraph 11 (as inserted by the Scheduled Diseases (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1973(c)) "Johne's disease" shall be deleted;

(2) after paragraph 12 there shall be inserted:

"13. *Johne's disease*: The compensation shall—

(a) where the animal slaughtered was affected with Johne's disease, be 75% of its value immediately before it was slaughtered; and

(b) in every other case, be the value of the animal immediately before it was slaughtered."

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)*

This Order amends Part II of the Second Schedule to the Diseases of Animals Act (Northern Ireland) 1958. Where an animal, slaughtered on account of Johne's disease, is found to be affected with the disease, the compensation payable shall be 75% of its value immediately before slaughter, and, in every other case, its full value immediately before slaughter.
