HORTICULTURE**Solid Pack Apples (Quality) (Amendment) Regulations
(Northern Ireland) 1978***Made* 21st July 1978*Coming into operation* 15th September 1978

The Department(a) of Agriculture in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Sections 13, 17, 18 and 33 of the Horticulture Act (Northern Ireland) 1966(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf and after consultation with such organisations as appear to be representative of interests affected by the regulations, hereby makes the following regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Solid Pack Apples (Quality) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1978 and shall come into operation on 15th September 1978.

Amendment of Principal Regulations

2. The Solid Pack Apples (Quality) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1977(c) shall be amended as follows:—

- (a) in regulation 6(1) the second sentence shall be deleted;
- (b) in regulation 3 in the definition of solid pack apples for “which has been subjected to a process of heat treatment and packed in a hermetically sealed container, and which has a pH of not more than 4.5” there shall be substituted “processed in accordance with a licence issued under Section 12 of the Act”;
- (c) in the heading of Part I of Schedule 2 “and minimum period of exposure to heat after filling and sealing” shall be deleted;
- (d) column 5 of Part I of Schedule 2 shall be deleted.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations amend the Solid Pack Apples (Quality) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1977 by deleting from the Regulations any references to methods of heat treatment of filled and sealed containers of solid pack apples and amending the definition of "solid pack apples".
