The Department of Manpower Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 1 of the Industrial Relations (No. 2) (Northern Ireland) Order 1976(a) and paragraph 2(1) and (2) of Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Industrial Relations (1976 No. 2 Order) (Commencement No. 3) Order (Northern Ireland) 1978.

Commencement

2. Articles 50 to 54 of the Industrial Relations (No. 2) (Northern Ireland) Order 1976, which relate to the disclosure of information by employers, shall come into operation on 9th October 1978.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order brings into operation on 9th October 1978 the provisions of the Industrial Relations (No. 2) (Northern Ireland) Order 1976 which relate to the disclosure of information by employers to trade union representatives for collective bargaining purposes.
