## FISHERIES

**Herring (Restriction of Fishing) (Amendment) Regulations  
(Northern Ireland) 1978**

*Made* . . . . . 26th September 1978

*Coming into operation* . 6.00 p.m. 26th September 1978

The Department(a) of Agriculture, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 19 and 124 of the Fisheries Act (Northern Ireland) 1966(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:

*Citation and commencement*

1. These regulations may be cited as the Herring (Restriction of Fishing) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1978 and shall come into operation at 6.00 p.m. on 26th September 1978.

*Amendment of regulations*

2. The provisions of the Herring (Restriction of Fishing) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1978(c) set out in the Schedule are hereby revoked.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)*

These regulations amend the Herring (Restriction of Fishing) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1978 so that the use of fishing boats of under 35 feet registered length for catching herring within a  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile off the Co. Down coast in the area which lies between a line running due east from the Roaring Rock (approximately  $54^{\circ} 10'N$ ) and a line running south-east from the Haulbowline Rocks (approximately  $54^{\circ}N$ ) previously permitted until 27th October 1978 is now prohibited from 6.00 p.m. on 26th September 1978.
