Factories (Standards of Lighting) (Revocation) Regulations
(Northern Ireland) 1978

Made 11th October 1978

Coming into operation 19th December 1978

The Department(a) of Manpower Services, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 5(2) of the Factories Act (Northern Ireland) 1965(b) and now vested in it(c), and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Factories (Standards of Lighting) (Revocation) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1978 and shall come into operation on 19th December 1978.

Revocation

2. The Factories (Standards of Lighting) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1941(d) are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These regulations revoke the Factories (Standards of Lighting) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1941 which laid down a minimum standard for factory lighting.
